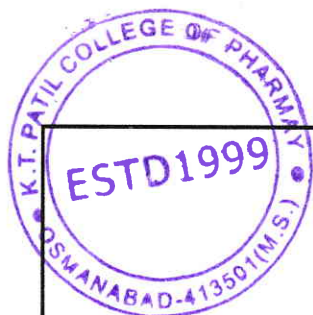

The minutes of the meeting are as follows:

Ms. Sapkale G. N. IQAC Coordinator begins the proceedings by briefing the members on the agenda of the internal quality assurance cell meeting.

1. Dr. Joshi A. A. Chairman expressed a warm welcome. And briefly introduced the objectives of IQAC. The IQAC committee was reconstituted for the academic year 2018-19. He further added that the newly appointed members have been informed and added in relevant documents
2. Faculty members have been encouraged to enhance online teaching through the use of PowerPoint presentations, study materials, and academic videos. Training sessions on digital tools and platforms are being organized for faculty. A structured schedule for internal assessments and examinations has been implemented, ensuring timely and organized evaluations. Guidelines for conducting university exams have been reviewed and shared with all relevant stakeholders to ensure clarity and compliance.
3. The following certificate courses are planned and will be conducted for B. Pharm Final Year students, with 58 participants in each course: Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Management, Pharmacovigilance Management, Regulatory Affairs Management, and Clinical Research Management. These courses aim to enhance students' knowledge and skills in key areas of pharmacy practice and research, preparing them for advanced professional roles. The courses will be structured to provide both theoretical understanding and practical exposure, aligning with industry standards and emerging trends
4. Ms. Katmore Poonam Hanumant and Ms. Sakhare Shivani Sunil have achieved remarkable success in the GPAT examination. Ms. Katmore secured an All India Rank of 1860, while Ms. Sakhare obtained an All India Rank of 3116. Their outstanding performances reflect their dedication, hard work, and commitment to advancing their academic careers in pharmacy, setting an inspiring example for their peers.
5. Faculty involvement in publishing research papers, filing patents, and authoring books significantly enhances academic excellence and the institution's reputation. These contributions promote innovation, bridge academia with industry, and provide valuable resources for students

and professionals. Such engagement strengthens the institution's research profile, aligning with NAAC and accreditation standards for quality education.

A one-day training program on Document Maintenance for Student Section was conducted on Saturday, 02/03/2019, with 7 participants. Both sessions successfully provided valuable insights and practical knowledge to the attendees.

8. The seminar on the Role of Pharmacist in Management of Adverse Drug Reactions & Pharmacovigilance will be organized at SSJP's, R. P. College of Pharmacy, Gadpati, Osmanabad, on 23/03/2019. The workshop Explore and Understand DNA will be conducted by Bioera Life Sciences Pvt. Ltd. on 3/8/2019 & 4/8/2019. The ABMH Pharmacon-VII, 2019 event will be held at Aditya Birla Memorial Hospital on 16/11/2019 & 17/11/2019. The Biostatistics, Epidemiology & Research Methodology (BERM-2019) workshop will be organized by Vignan Pharmacy College, Vadlamudi, Guntur, A.P., on 26/09/2019 & 28/09/2019. Avishkar-2018 was held at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, from 3/1/2019 to 5/1/2019, with 1 participant. The Osmanabad District Avishkar-2018 event took place at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, sub-campus, Osmanabad, on 10/12/2018, with 1 participant.

Ms. Sapkale G. N. thanked all the members for attending the meeting and informed all the members that the next IQAC meeting will be held in July 2019

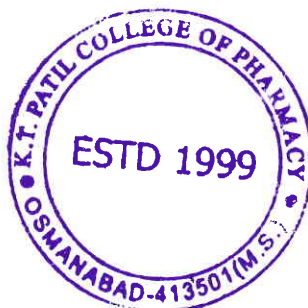
